



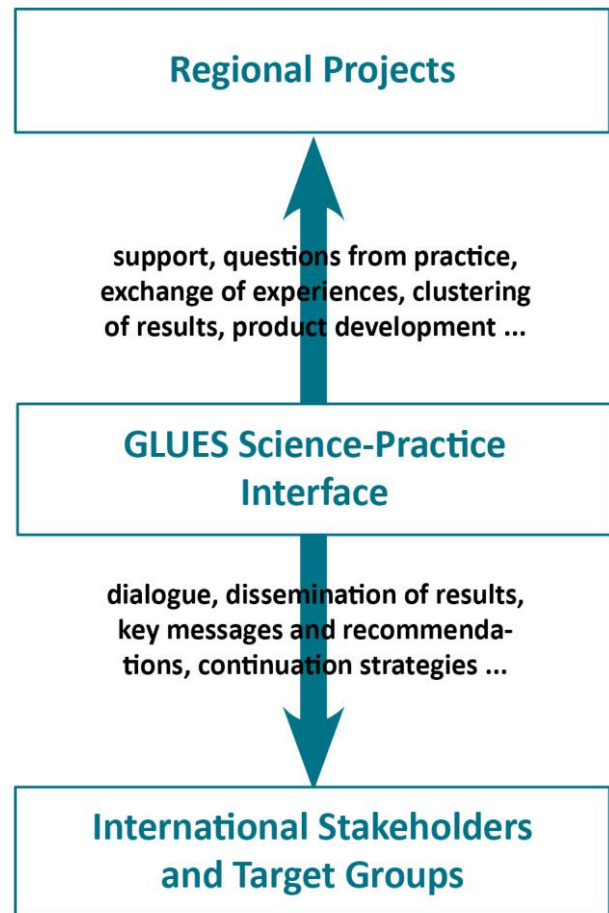
■ GLUES – Science-practice interface

■ What is the science-practice interface about?

The science-practice interface links the work and results of the regional projects with international stakeholders from different worlds of sustainable land management practice: It feeds questions and needs of various potential users of research results into the Sustainable Land Management programme and supports development and dissemination of overarching results and products to different target groups.

■ GLUES Stakeholder management provides and delivers:

- An overarching analysis of international stakeholders in the practice of sustainable land management.
- Identification of key results from the regional projects and their adaptation for different target groups.
- Facilitating interactions between international stakeholders and Sustainable Land Management programme partners.
- Support of experiences exchange on joint topics among the regional projects, and clustering of projects.
- Development of continuation strategies and overarching results at the programme level.
- Preparation of a guideline for stakeholder analysis and involvement.
- Support of regional projects in their own stakeholder integration and continuation strategy.
